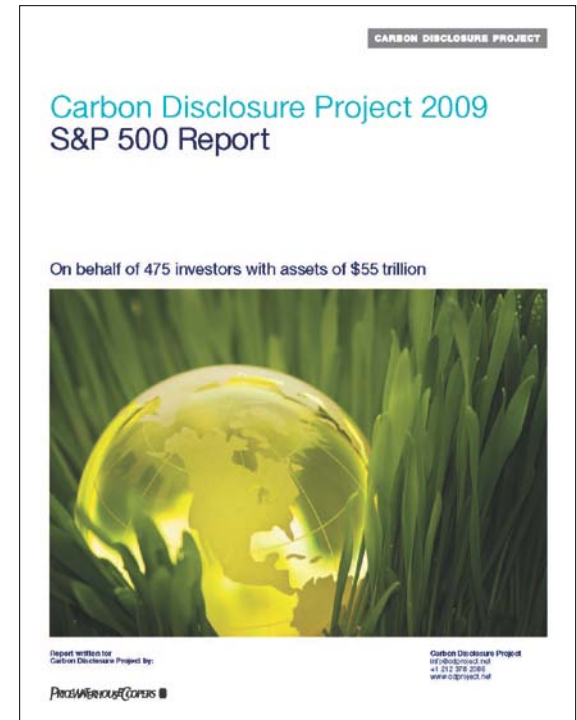


CARBON DISCLOSURE PROJECT

Introduction

- Independent not-for-profit organization holding world's largest database of corporate climate change data
- Over 2,500 companies disclose annually
- CDP is the gold standard for carbon reporting
- Selected by Walmart as standard reporting system for its suppliers.



Walmart's completion of CDP's 2006 questionnaire provided the company with "valuable insight" including the fact that the refrigerants used in grocery stores accounted for a larger percentage of Walmart's greenhouse gas footprint than its truck fleet.

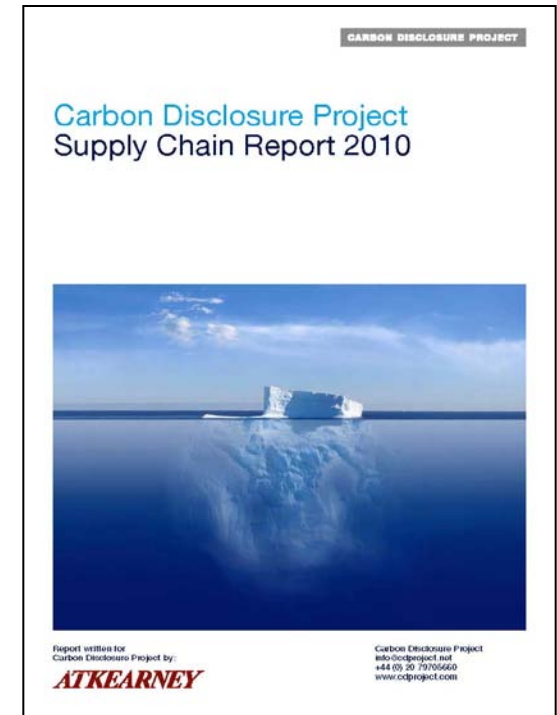
- Complete the '**Energy and Climate**' section of *Supplier Sustainability Assessment* in its entirety

CDP: What is Involved?

CARBON DISCLOSURE PROJECT

The CDP Questionnaire inquires about:

- **Governance** – responsibility within the company
- **Risks & Opportunities** from climate change
- **Strategy** – targets, plans, reduction goals
- **Emissions reporting** – GHG calculations
- **Energy use** – e.g. data from utility bills
- **Climate Change Communications** – Annual Reports.



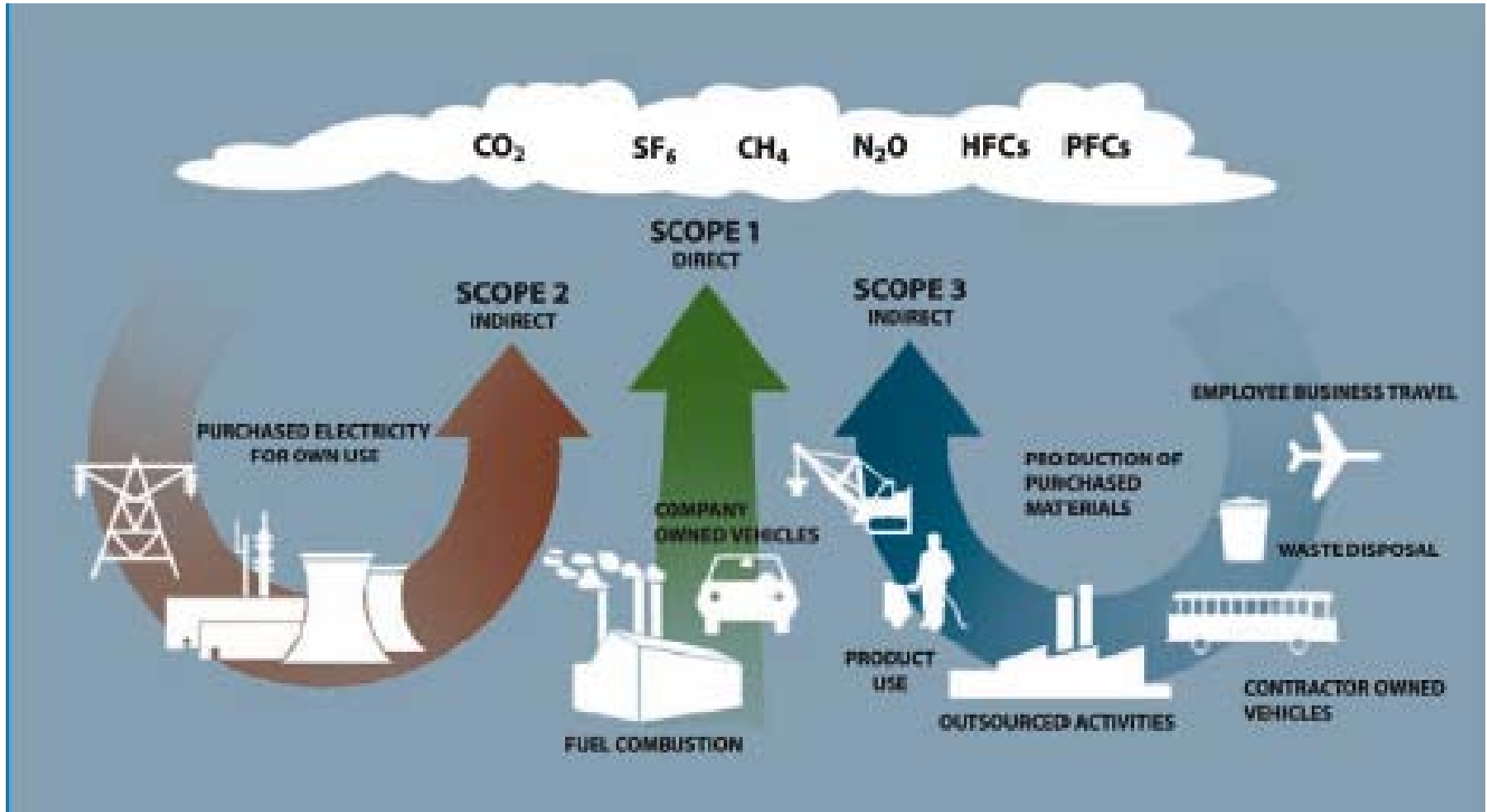
